

**DRAFT RECESSED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND SELECTMEN
OF THE CITY OF WEST POINT, MISSISSIPPT
TUESDAY, January 21, 2014
2:00 P.M.**

This is a recessed meeting of our regular meeting of the Board of Mayor and Selectmen of the City of West Point, held the 3rdth day of January 2014, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall conference room, 204 Commerce Street, West Point, Mississippi. Members present were Mayor Harmon “Robbie” Robinson, City Attorney Orlando Richmond, Selectwoman Hannah, Selectman William Binder, and Selectman Dedeaux. Those absent were Selectman Keith McBrayer and Selectman Jimmy Clark.

Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order along with invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Robinson called for a motion to accept the bids for bonds on the renovation of the McClure Building in the amount of \$460,000. Mayor stated that the City will stand for the bonds and the Growth Alliance will reimburse the City the full amount to retire the bonds. Bids that were accepted were Duncan-Williams Inc., Cadence Bank, and Citizens Bank and Trust Company of Marks, Mississippi. The lowest bid went to Cadence Bank with a rate of 4.53%.

Selectman Dedeaux moved to accept the bid of Cadence Bank with a rate of 4.53%.

The motion received a second by Selectman Binder.

Hearing no further discussion, Mayor Robinson called for a vote and the results were as follows:

Mayor Robinson called for a motion from the Board approving a grant application with MDOT for a walking trail. The City of West Point certifies that no known foreseeable legal impediments exist that would prohibit completion of the walking trail adjacent to

the Sam Wilheit Transportation Museum and that the project complies with applicable codes, standards and/or regulations required for completion.

Selectwoman Hannah moved to accept approval of the grant application with MDOT for the walking trail.

Motion received a second by Selectman Binder.

Hearing no further discussion, Mayor Robinson called for a vote and the results were as follows:

Selectman Keith McBrayer voted: Absent
