

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Although several procedures have been implemented to reduce the undesirable social proximity issues with over the counter proximity for various transactions. To preclude potential risks associated with the social distancing policy mandated by the CDC, national, state, and local emergency declarations and orders to help control the spread of COVID-19 virus, the Board of Mayor and Selectmen for the City of West Point, MS find it is in the best interest of the taxpayer and office employees to temporarily suspend face to face interaction with the general public.

As a result, and in addition to the current social distancing procedures and preclude routine over the counter transactions for paying property taxes, renewing privilege licenses, etc., citizens may conduct their transactions by using the drop box located in the gated foyer next to the primary entrance to City Hall.

Anyone unsure of current property (ad valorem) taxes due for any parcel of land for city and school district taxes may call City Hall at (662) 494-2573 and have the clerk determine the most current tax and interest due.

Once you are sure of the amount due, you may remit by placing your payment in an envelope provide at the gate. Payment must be in the form described on the door and window notices. On the envelope for taxes, please write-in the parcel or tax receipt ID for which taxes are due, the property owner's name, the payee's name, if different from the property owner, a phone number and a mailing address for the preferred receipt delivery location.
