

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
SELECTMEN
FOR THE CITY OF WEST POINT, MISSISSIPPI
Tuesday, July 7, 2020 5:30 P.M.**

The Board of Mayor and Selectmen of the City of West Point, Mississippi held a special called meeting and budget hearing the 7th day of July 2020 at 5:30 p.m. upstairs at City Hall, 580 Commerce Street, West Point, Mississippi. Members present were Mayor Harmon A. "Robbie" Robinson, presiding, Selectwoman Leta Turner, Selectman William Binder, Selectman Keith McBrayer, and Selectman Jasper Pittman.
