

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
SELECTMEN  
FOR THE CITY OF WEST POINT, MISSISSIPPI  
Monday, March 29, 2021 9:00 A.M.**

The Board of Mayor and Selectmen of the City of West Point, Mississippi held a special called meeting the 29th day of March 2021 at 9:00 a.m. upstairs at City Hall, 580 Commerce Street, West Point, Mississippi. Members present were Mayor Harmon A. “Robbie” Robinson, presiding; Selectwoman Leta Turner, Selectman William Binder, and Selectman Jasper Pittman.
