Residential Garbage & Rubbish Collection

Thursday Household Garbage Collection:

Call Public Works Department at (662) 494-3513 for your scheduled day for garbage pickup

- Household garbage should be placed in plastic bags, securely tied, and placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 p.m. on the day prior (Wednesday afternoon) to your scheduled pick-up day.
- Pickup begins as 7:30 A.M.
- Loose garbage will not be picked up.
- Garbage bags are delivered twice a year. Extra bags may be purchased at City Hall.
- Problems with animals tearing into garbage? Spray small amounts of ammonia, Lysol or Clorox on bags.
- Garbage will not be picked-up out of or off any type container other than a household type garbage can.

Rubbish Collection:

- All Rubbish needs to be out by 7:30 am on Monday for pick-up.
- Yard clippings, leaves and other small rubbish must be bagged and placed at the curb. Large rubbish/leaf bags are available at City Hall for a small charge. Please do not use rubbish bags for garbage.
- Medium size rubbish such as brush and limbs may be placed loose at the curb. Maximum size is 6' in length and 4" in diameter. Please DO NOT place rubbish in the street or gutter.
- Contractors employed by property owners to cut trees, brush, limbs, etc are responsible for debris removal and proper disposal. An additional 25% penalty will be added to the normal pickup fees if the City collects these type cuttings.
- Rubbish will not be picked-up out of or off any type container.
- Rubbish items that will be picked up routinely:

Bagged:

Yard Clippings
Small brush and trimmings
Leaves

Loose:

Medium size limbs/brush less than 6 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter
Small wood items
Cardboard boxes

Non-vegetative rubbish items may be picked up by the City but on a special schedule for an additional charge by special request. If items in this category are placed at the curb without prior coordination with the Public Works Department, they will be considered by the City to have been placed there by the resident who agrees to accept pick-up at an additional charge. The additional charges will be automatically billed to the resident's Water & Light account.

*These items include:

Tires	Garbage mixed with Rubbish	Large items of furniture
Carpet-Floor Covering	Stumps and commercial tree cuttings	Mattresses and box springs
Over-sized limbs	Appliances and TV's	Loose leaves
		Major landscaping debris

*Some rubbish items that **WILL NOT** be picked up because of the type of materials include:

Construction debris Batteries Motor oil Liquids of any kind Chemicals Paint

Contractors & Lawn Service Providers

Anyone other than a property owner performing his own tree, shrub, lawn or construction service at his place of residence are responsible for removal of all debris and should do so before the property owner pays for such services. **No blowing of yard clippings & grass on to the City streets.**
